SCHOOL HALL UPDATE

Following the email sent home yesterday, we would once again like to apologise for the disruption caused by the closure of the school hall. We can confirm that we invited a contractor to look at the apex roof to inspect what appeared to be a crack in one of the glass panels and to quote for necessary repair works. Following his visit yesterday morning, we were advised to close the school hall until a survey could take place to ensure that the pane of glass was not dangerous. We are pleased to say that the County Council acted promptly on our request for clarification and a survey took place today. The hall has now been deemed safe to use, although works are needed to repair the roof. Therefore the hall can now be used as planned in the upcoming weeks, with the only disruption occurring on the day we actually have contractors in to begin the necessary works.

SCHOOL MEALS

The Premises, Health and Safety committee of the Governing Body met today at school. One of the items on the agenda was the standard of the school meals provided by Dolce as some concerns have been passed on to the school. The committee are actively looking into these concerns and will be carrying out spot checks on the standards and reporting back to the governing body. In addition Mrs Reid eats the meals with the children on a regular basis and is able to keep an eye on the quality of the food and the portion sizes being served. We recognise that some pupils do not like the option that has been chosen for them on a particular day and the staff encourage pupils to try as much as they can and ensure they have eaten enough food before they leave the table. To support this we would also encourage families to sit down and order the food together so that the children can tell you if they have tried one of the options before and would prefer to change their option. If you have any further specific concerns about the quality of the food on any given day, or a question you wish to raise, this can be done either through your class parent representative, or by email to the school office. Dolce also have the facility for you to either rate your meals through your live kitchen login, or you can pass on your comments to the live kitchen support team at support@livekitchen.co.uk
