Health:

We wanted to make you aware that it is currently tick season. Ticks can be found in a number of areas such as: woodland, moorlands and grassy areas. Tick bites aren't usually painful and sometimes only cause a red lump to develop where you were bitten. However, in some cases they may cause: swelling, itchiness, blistering and bruising. Keep an eye on anywhere you've been bitten by a tick. There's no need to consult your GP if you've been bitten and have no symptoms. However, if you develop a rash or experience flu-like symptoms after being bitten, then you should see your GP. More information can be found <u>here</u>
