KS2 Class Structures for 2016 - 2017

Each year we look at the class structures for September based on the number of pupils in each year group and how to provide them with equality of access to teacher input time, the highest standard of education and the 'challenge for all' that we pride ourselves on here at Frieth. We expect that from September 2016 our cohort sizes will be as follows:

| Year 3 | Year 4 | Year 5 | Year 6 |
|--------|--------|--------|--------|
| 20 | 20 | 21 | 14 |

This gives us an expected total of at least 75 pupils across 3 classes although we are expecting additional families to join the school in KS2 in September.

The KS2 structure will therefore remain as it has been in the 2015-2016 academic year and provide 3 classes with approximately equivalent numbers; keep all class sizes to a minimum; and provide equality of access to teacher input for all pupils. As such there will be 3 mixed age classes in KS2 in September: a class of mixed year 3 and 4, a class of mixed year 4 and 5 and a class of mixed year 5 and 6 pupils. Year 6 will remain together and year 3 will remain together. For the well-being of all pupils, the decision will not be made on academic ability, but will be based primarily on age and the professional judgement of the staff. The finalised class lists will be sent home with pupil reports on the 8th July.
