As some of you may be aware, on the 25th May 2018 the new General **Data Protection** Regulations come into force. Some of the changes to the data protection regulations mean that we, as a school, have to audit and review our policies and provision to safeguard any personal data we hold for our pupils, families, staff and governors. As part of this process we have now uploaded our draft Privacy Notice, Data Protection policy and our linked policies such as Social Media Policy and our E-Safety Policy to a new page on the school website. We have also drafted a new Image Consent form which will be sent home to all families once it has been agreed formally by the governing body.
