It has been another exciting week of learning at Frieth. As you can see, Kestrels class were having lots of fun in Gymnastics, using their skills on our large apparatus.



Also, on Wednesday, we had a visit from 'Fuze' who led coding workshops for KS2 children. They brought in lots of equipment and technology including robotic arms that linked to the 'Rasberry Pie' based computers. The children learnt how to write in a completely different coding

language in order to make things appear on the screen, operate a light sensor and make the robotic arm move. Pupils have been given the opportunity to evaluate the workshops and have written: Everyone enjoyed the coding' and 'It was really fun to learn how to write code and it would be amazing if we could get some of those resources'. #### Whole School Meeting—Wednesday 20th January

There will be a whole school meeting on Wednesday 20th January. #### Medicines in School

If medicines are required to be administered at school please be aware that you will need to bring them in with the necessary forms completed (available from the school office), in their original packaging, un-opened and labelled with your child's name. Please note, the school policy for the administration of medicine states that members of staff are not allowed to administer Paracetamol, Calpol, Ibuprofen or any other over the counter painkillers, and pupils are not allowed to have cough sweets or syrups in school without a prescription from your doctor. If your child is unwell and need regular top ups of painkilling medicine, we ask that parents arrange to come into school to administer the medicine themselves or that the pupils are kept at home until they are well enough to get through the day without painkillers.

#### Lettings policy and use of school grounds

When hiring the school hall for parties or events outside of school hours, our school lettings policy asks that the hirers only drive 1 essential car onto the playground for the purposes of unloading and ensure that the gate is partially closed to stop any other cars driving onto the playground. If you are collecting a child or attending an event at the school outside of school hours, please support our policy by parking in the front car park or on the road and walking through to the playground. Thank you.

#### Church Walls and Railings

We would be grateful if you would ensure children do not climb on the church walls, railings, hedges or play in the churchyard before or after school as this is a safety concern.

#### Meetings with Teachers

If you need to meet with a teacher please make an appointment via the school office.



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#### Winter Weather Uniform

As the weather gets colder please ensure your child comes to school with a sweatshirt and warm winter coat every day. For PE sessions please ensure they have their full PE kit including warm tracksuit bottoms and trainers and a sweatshirt.
