How much have we raised and what have we provided for the school this year?

The balance at the start of the academic year was c.£18,000, with all of your amazing help and effort throughout the year we managed to generate another £14,000 to that! The total amount requested by the school and given since last September was an incredible £26,000!!!! This is money that has been generated by us all, and all of it has gone back into the school to benefit the children. If there's ever any incentive in lending a hand for a little

bit, for the setting up, the taking down, the trips to Asda for supplies, the shift behind the stall, the ticket selling, the BBQ, the decorations, the planning, the advertising, the hunt for prizes and sponsors, it is with the knowledge that all of your help raises funds (actual money!) that is used by the school.

So what has it been spent on?

This astonishing amount has been able to provide the school with following;

- The refurbishment of Owls toilets (**Melanie Sharpe** you are an absolute diamond!! A massive thank you to **Janine Turner and Zoe Bater** for assisting with the painting on a Saturday!)
 - A new floor for the school hall
 - New tables for the hall
 - A new table and new chairs for the library
 - An educational trip to RAF Hendon
 - The visiting Pantomime
 - Christmas lunch for the children
 - Reading Eggs
 - Mathletics
 - First News Subscription
 - Travel expenses / coach journeys for days out
 - Twinkle online teaching resource
 - New fridge
 - Coding
 - New iPads

The money that will be raised from the Hilly this year will all go directly to the cost of the new and improved play area and forest school which, if you were able to see the plans at Sports Day, looks absolutely amazing!! The children are so excited! Another huge thank you to **Mel Sharpe** again for that one!

Imagine *not* being able to provide these things? The children having to go without school trips, online resources, new play equipment, iPads, newly refurbished areas within the school, festive fun in December, no extras full stop.
