**Message from Mrs Reid**

Following on from my last newsletter, I have been continuing my learning walks and observations of teaching and learning around the school with members of staff. We are particularly interested in science at the moment, and so I had the privilege of observing our Kestrels class investigating the phases of the moon with the use of spheres on sticks and torchlight, and I believe they will be recreating a certain 'Jaffa Cake' advert today to reinforce their learning about the phases of the moon. (although other round biscuits varieties are available!)

In Kites class there were some fantastic investigations into forces with the use of plasticene boats, guttering water courses, fans and ball bearings. This was all tied neatly into a cross curricular history discussion about the forces at work on the Titanic after it hit the ice berg. The school display boards also show the wealth of work across the curriculum being completed by the pupils and staff including: gorgeous poetry and fact files based on Remembrance; topic homework postcards;



Science habitats in KS1; Woodland Creatures; Character Profiles; RE prayers and writing about Sikhism; French and German Christmas songs for pupils to learn; and lots of learning walls showing the latest lessons for English, Maths.

In addition to our learning inside, our Forest School has taken off with our Reception Owls taking part in the first 6 week block. They are



having a brilliant time with Miss 'Squirrel' and Miss 'Cheetah'! There are some fantastically muddy faces and lovely environmental art work on display in the pictures on the pupil pages of the school website.
