## House Music Competition

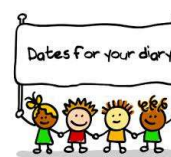
It has been wonderful to see so many children audition for this year's talent event. With 40 pupils taking part, the standard was incredibly high, and our staff had some very tough decisions to make.
