On Tuesday 19th April 2016 we welcomed Mrs Walley from the National Society into school for the day. She spoke with children, staff, governors, myself and parents. She also examined the pupils' work in books and on display; watched lessons being taught; and took an in -depth look at the performance outcomes for the pupils. Within the four key categories for inspection, Mrs Walley reports that:
