### Maths - for children in **green, yellow** and **white** groups

LO: Read and interpret pie charts.

- Start by logging into [TTRS](#) and practicing your times tables! Remember the school postcode is RG9 6PR.
- Then you need to head to [Education City](#) and watch the 'learn screens' on pie charts which have been set up for you.
- Next you need to work through the PowerPoint called 'Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> and Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June Read and interpret pie charts'.
- **Go through slides 2-13 only.** You will look at the other slides tomorrow.
- Activity sheets to complete are then also to be found below this pdf. They are called 'Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June Maths and ANSWERS'. There are 3 sheets - each sheet gets progressively harder. The answers to the questions are on the final sheet of the document.
