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## **REMINDERS:**

Whole school Photograph; The whole school photo is a very special event that takes place every 7 years. This year it will be taken on Thursday 23rd May. Pupils are expected to be in their normal, neat and tidy, school uniform on the day of the photo. This can be either the summer or winter uniform.

Work Share Afternoon: This coming Thursday is our summer term work share afternoon. Parents are warmly invited to come in with their child or children and spend time sharing their work with them.

This is an opportunity for your child to talk about the work they are proud of and their learning in school and they should remain with their parents in school. Should they need to reapply, each child should have their own clearly named cream which they should be able to apply themselves. For safety reasons, children are not allowed to use another child's cream. Please also ensure your child has a named sun hat and brings a bottle of water into school with them.
