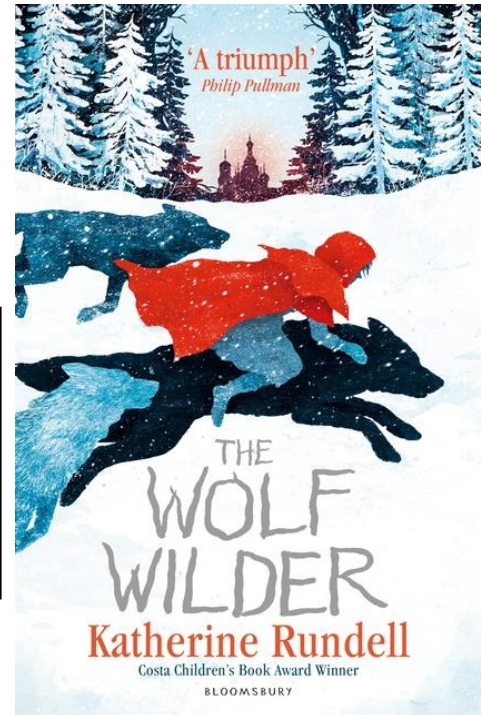


## MY BOOK REVIEW
