Covid Plea...

Last week, we were told that it was highly unlikely for the Covid restrictions to be lifted in this area, given the rising numbers in Buckinghamshire. I am sure this is not a surprise to you all. In terms of school numbers in Bucks, there were 6700 children isolating last week (just over 8% of the school population) with 47 schools affected. There were 195 children with a positive test including one school with 51 positive cases. This is likely to have risen since then. Please could I therefore appeal to you to be careful over the holidays, thinking twice about mixing with families from other schools. We have been lucky so far and we don't want that to change. Having said that, I do wish you all a very Merry Christmas and a Happy and Covid-free new year!
