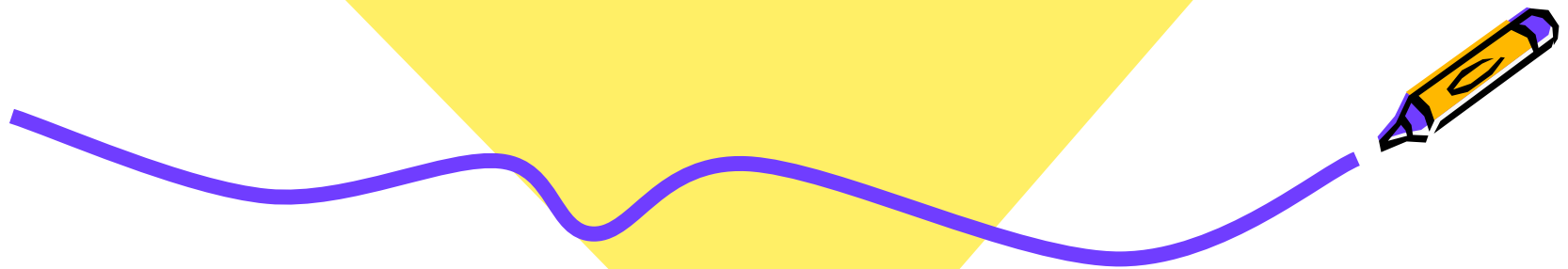

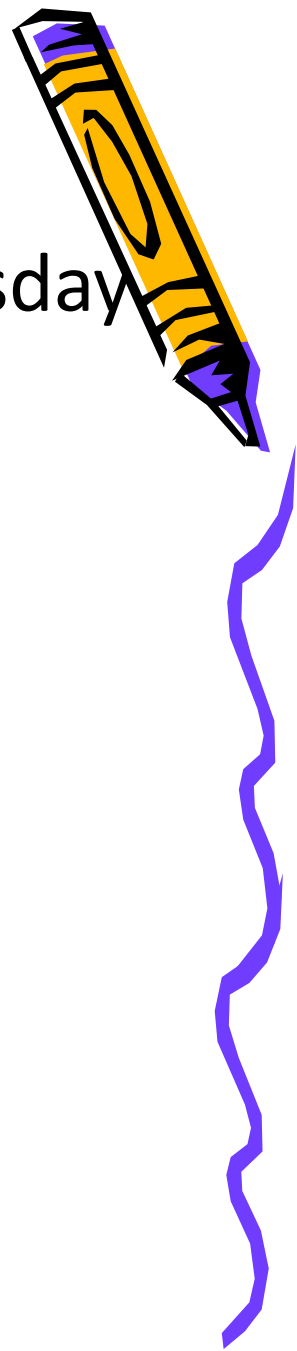

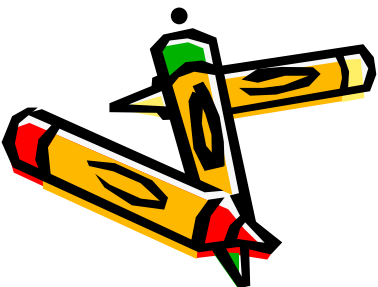
Equipment in school

- Reading books – every day

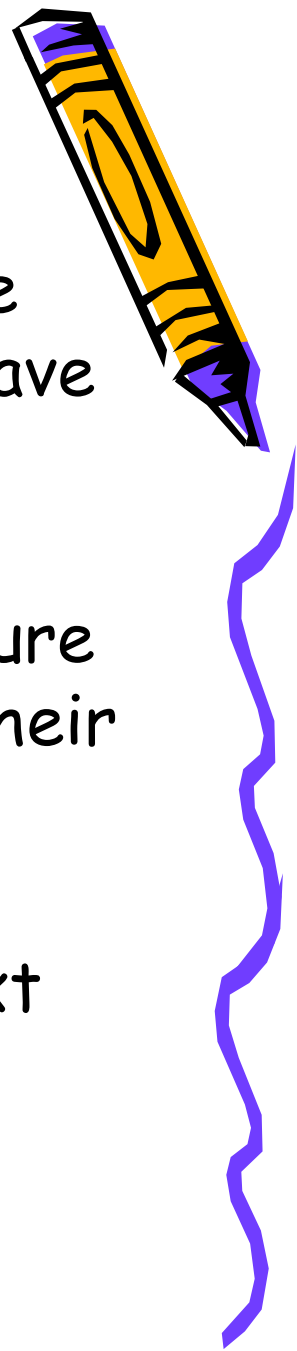


Homework

SATs

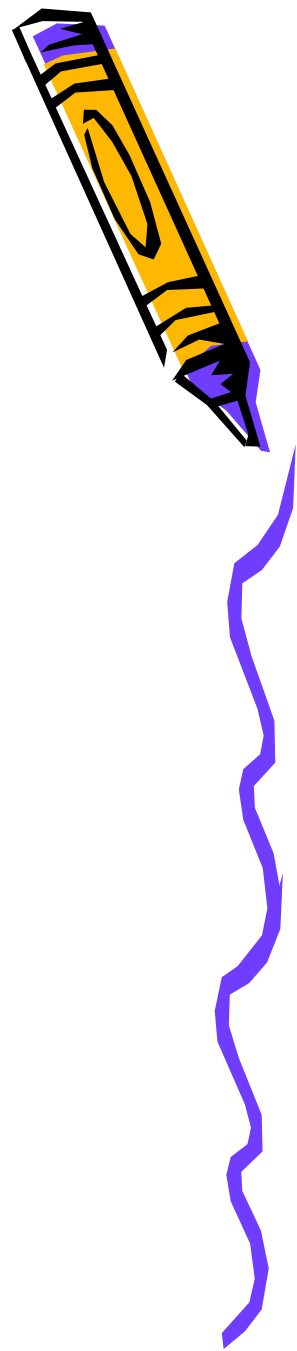
In May, pupils will take national tests in:
