Saxon Day

On the 5th of June a man called Lord Uhtred (AKA Andrew) from 'History off the Page' came in to teach us about the Saxons.



In the morning, we went to stalls which were being run by parent volunteers or teachers and each one had a fun activity to complete. There was: candle making, gargoyle face making, rune writing, pouch making, decorative rune writing, bracelet making, brooch making, weaving, medicine making, Thor's hammer making and some people also got to go hunting.







The morning ended with each class learning how to make a shield wall. Once we had made the wall, Lord Untred tried to break through it; he wasn't successful!

By doing this we learnt how important battle tactics are and it helped us appreciate how the Saxons managed to defeat the Viking invaders.

In the afternoon, we learnt about archaeology. Everybody enjoyed digging in mud boxes, trying to discover hidden historical artefacts and identify what their purpose might have been.

The afternoon ended with Lord Uhtred smelting metal in the Hall and making 3 necklaces for each Key Stage 2 class. He used some of the clay brooch moulds that we had made during the morning workshop to We had a really fantastic Saxon Day and learnt a lot!
