Lunch Provider update

As you are aware from previous correspondence, we would like to return to our previous provider, Dolce.

As previously explained, in order for us to make this change we would need to be able to ensure we have a minimum of 73 orders per day or the school would incur a charge. We therefore set up a short survey (available on ScoPay under Clubs & Trips) to help give us an indication of possible numbers.

Unfortunately, we are still awaiting responses from 49 parents. We have therefore made this survey live again until the 27th January.

We will be unable to make any decision around changing our provider until we have the completed survey.
