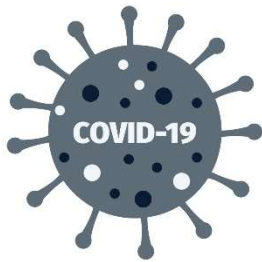
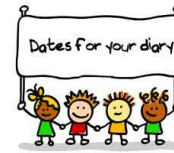


After a number of cancellations due to COVID, it's been great to see the children across Key Stage 2 enjoy some sport last week. The
