**Re: Key Stage 2 Trip to Chiltern Open Air Museum**

To compliment this term's creative curriculum topic of 'Stone Age to Iron Age', a Key Stage 2 trip to the Chiltern Open Air Museum has been organised for **Friday, 23rd November**. The trip will take place during the normal school day and we will aim to arrive back in school by 3:15pm for pick up as usual.

During the course of the day all the children will get to tour the site as well as participating in a 'Stone Age' workshop. The workshop is set during the Mesolithic period, the 'middle' Stone Age, and during this session, the children will focus on hunting and gathering skills. With the on-site educators, they will also have a go at starting a fire and creating a temporary shelter; learning about using the environment to sustain life.

As the site is entirely outdoors, it is important that all pupils are wearing appropriate attire for outdoor work. Children will need to wear long-sleeves and trousers covering their legs. They will need to wear either wellies or walking boots and should have warm outerwear and waterproofs. **Children are not to wear school uniform.**

Please **do not** send in pocket money or phones/cameras for the trip. The children will need to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle in a backpack. Children who normally have a school lunch can be provided with a packed lunch by DOLCE – please place your order in the usual way in advance.

The PTA have kindly agreed to subsidise the travel element of the trip. However, if you are able to make a voluntary contribution for the full amount per child to reduce the cost to the PTA, this would be much appreciated.

Total cost per child £13

Suggested voluntary contribution per child £9.
