I am going to start on a more sobering note than usual.

All of us have been following the war in Ukraine with horror and disbelief. I am aware that many parents have understandably shielded the children from the news and as a school we have taken the decision not to deliver any formal lessons or assemblies in relation to this. However, staff have also been prepared to field any questions from the pupils following guidance provided from the local authority.

Buckinghamshire County Council have been advised by central government that we can expect the arrival of Ukrainian refugees across the country over the next few weeks and we know that the people of Buckinghamshire will be generous in taking these families in and keeping them safe in our community. I have been in contact with a group of households / families in Frieth who are hoping to be able to host refugees from Ukraine and have enquired about school spaces. It is therefore highly probable that after Easter we will be welcoming children into the school who are refugees from Ukraine. At this point I do not know timescales or numbers, but I will keep parents informed as soon as I know anything. Of course, before the children come we will need to make our currents pupils aware and I assure you this will be handled extremely sensitively and age appropriately.

The refugee population is overwhelmingly made up of women and children, and in order for them to feel safe and valued in this country, a school place will be a key element in their support. It is important that we all do our best to support these victims of war and welcome them into our school communities with empathy and compassion.

As a school I feel we should also make a contribution to support all victims of the war so I would like to have a mufti day on Thursday 7th April. All proceeds will go towards helping refugees.



There will be a short Mothering Sunday family service at 3.00 p m on Sunday 27th in Frieth Church to which all pupils and parents are warmly invited, and when Mums (and sometimes Grannies, depending on numbers!) are given their posies. With the help of some of our governors, these have been made by our children from Owls and Buzzards Class today.



Once again, the netballers have 'let their light shine' with an emphatic win against Burford and nail-biting victory of Bledlow Ridge. All the practice over the year has clearly paid off as team notched up 15-3 and 11-10 wins. Awesome work team!



Next week we will be launching our maths passports. As well as earing times tables awards, the children will also have the opportunity to earn other passports linked to various areas of maths. Mrs Goodchild will be in touch next week to explain more.
