Maths - If you **are not** in the below groups, please log-in and complete the classwork cities which have been set up for you on [Education City](#). You can also go to [TTRS](#) and practice your time tables too.

Maths - for children in **green, yellow** and **white** groups

- Start by practicing your tables on [TTRS](#). Remember the school postcode is RG9 6PR.
- Then, I would like to see how you have been getting on with ratio and proportion by seeing how you do on an online assessment.
- You need to head to [mathletics](#) and log-in. You should find that you have been assigned a 'test' on ratio and proportion to complete.
