What instrument will I need?

Children will need an instrument for lessons and also to practice at home.

Do I need to already have my own instrument?

No! We are happy to provide ukuleles and guitars for hire or purchase.

How can I help my child learn?

Encouragement, time, instrument, music stand and a place to practice! Every child will be given music for each session. Please keep an eye on this to see how they are progressing, and feel free to use it to keep in touch with the teacher.

How much are lessons and how many are there?

Club fees are £6.25 per weekly group session (held at the 2019/20 rates). Sessions are booked on a termly basis. There are 10 sessions this term. We require a half term's written notice of cancellation of lessons.
