I very pleased to report the new term has started smoothly and children have settled back well.

I was looking forward to reporting to you on some exciting events that we had planned this week but unfortunately, after a few COVID-19 cases in the first week, we have had a small outbreak in Kites and Eagles meaning these two classes have had to be put into bubbles this week. Therefore the sports fixtures we had organised along with The Garsington Opera Company visit, was cancelled. The good news is if there are no more cases before next week, then these classes can go back to normal on Monday.

Overall case numbers in Buckinghamshire are going down but they are still very high in school age children particularly primary so we must remain vigilant. I would like to remind parents that if your child has any symptoms of COVID-19, they must take a PCR test not a Lateral Flow test.

As you saw from my email earlier this week, there was a further change to the isolation period rules yesterday with those who have tested positive able to stop isolating from day 6 if there have been two sequential negative daily LFT's at least 24 hours apart. It has been reported that many people are still testing positive on days 6, 7, 8 and 9 but the new rules does mean that people can come out of isolation earlier with negative tests.



I would like to extend my thanks to local resident, Nigel Page and parent, Caroline Priestley who, last year, ran a Calendar Competition with the

aim of both engaging local residents in the community and raising money for our school. Nigel
