The appointment system will **not** be available to make bookings outside of these dates. You will need to login with your Childs FULL first name, surname and date of birth, and your details, including the correct salutation of Ms/Mrs/Mr.

It is preferable that teachers are able to talk to parents without any children present, **please arrange alternative child care for that afternoon or evening. This is especially important this term as Mrs Reid will be in the hall and unable to supervise waiting children, and for safety reasons we cannot let pupils sit and wait in the library or leave the entrance door unattended.**

We would like to emphasise that these meetings are an opportunity to discuss your child's general progress and are not intended to be an occasion to raise specific problems. If you would like to talk at greater length with your child's teacher about any issues which are worrying you, please make a separate appointment.

Appointments will take place in the school hall and will be timetabled at 10 minute intervals. We must try to adhere to this timetable as many parents have appointments with other class teachers, we hope you will understand when after 10 minutes the teacher will indicate that the meeting is over.
