Message from Mrs Reid

Welcome back to the summer term at Frieth. This is always the busiest term at school and we have lots of learning challenges and fabulous activities to look forward to. The Yr 6 and Yr 2 pupils will be taking their statutory end of key stage assessments (SAT's) in May. The children in year 1 will be taking the phonics screening check in June and the children in years 1, 3, 4 and 5 will be taking end of year non-statutory assessments during the summer term. These tests are used to assess how much progress they have made over the year and to plan how we can best provide for their future progress. Regular attendance is always important to learning in school, but it is particularly important during the assessment period in order for the tests and tasks to be completed efficiently and provide the best conditions for the pupils to demonstrate their fantastic progress. It is very difficult for teaching staff to organise the time and staff allocation required to enable pupils who have been



absent to sit the tests the rest of the class have already completed. Having to sit a test by themselves without the rest of the class can also have a detrimental impact on how well a child performs. For these reasons we ask that parents do not request any absence during this time, except in the case of essential medical appointments, and only keep children at home if they are too ill to attend school or highly infectious.

The term's enrichment activities got off to a flying start. Well done to our Year 5 pupils who took part in a Dodgeball Festival organised by our PE providers Club Sport. The children worked really well in their teams and had a great morning of competition and fun.

Mr Honey has been busy setting up the trial of the new 'Marty' Robots in school. The robots have been provided for a trial before we commit the hard earned PTA fundraising money into purchasing the set for the school. Kestrels class had great fun using the commands to programme the robots to dance, walk and wiggle around the tables. One robot even found its way down the corridor to the office to ask Mrs Horan for a cup of tea! We are now working on setting up a special version of 'Scratch' to programme our own commands for the robots.

The trial has had a very positive start and if this

continues, the 'Marty' Robots will become part of our school resources, enabling us to enrich the robotics section of the computing curriculum for all our children at Frieth. Thank you to the PTA for agreeing to the expenditure for the purchase of the robots.

And talking of the PTA, the AGM was held this week. Thank you to everyone who attended and to the committee members who have been voted in for the coming year. Bertie Bayliss and Richard Piercy will be cochairs; Leah Cubbage will be the treasurer; and Lisa Martin will be the secretary.
