On Friday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2017 at 1.00pm, we are holding our annual 'Summer Queen' celebrations. For those of you who are new to Frieth School, Summer Queen is always a joyous occasion when we say thank you and farewell, to our outgoing Head and Deputy Head girls and boys and welcome in the new Head and Deputy Head boys and girls. As entertainment, each class performs a song or dance. There are speeches from the outgoing Head Boy and Head Girl, and from the Chair of Governors and the Head Teacher.

Traditionally the children are dressed in their best finery appropriate to the weather conditions:

- The girls wear their smartest dresses/skirts and blouse with their shoulders covered
- The boys wear their 'Sunday Best' clothes: long trousers and long-sleeved shirts. The shirt can be striped, checked or plain, but no super-heroes etc. They will not need a tie.
- The girls wear a floral hairband and the boys a floral buttonhole. We place a block order from school with a local florist for the headbands and buttonholes but some families prefer to make their own.

Because all the pupils will be dancing at some point during the performance, suitable closed toe shoes should be worn. If pupils wear sandals, they will be asked to change into PE trainers/plimsolls for the performance.

At the end of the afternoon, the children return to their classrooms. We ask that you come promptly to the classrooms to collect your children. You will then be able to enjoy the refreshments and entertainment that the PTA have organised for all Frieth School's families.
