Message from the Junior Road Safety Officers

You will have noticed that the JRSO's have been standing outside the front of the school at the start of the school day. JRSO's are Junior Road Safety Officers. We are here to make sure that all of the children coming to school are safe.

We wanted to remind you that you can park at the Yew Tree at the start and end of the school day, which will reduce the number of cars parking outside the school. The speed limit in the village is 30 miles per hour, but we would like to encourage you to go even slower for everybody's safety. Please remember not to block people's drives and to leave spaces so that buses can get into and out of the school playground safely.

The turning circle seems to be working well, but please remember that drivers should not get out of the car. Children need to be able to get out themselves so that the traffic keeps moving. If your child is not able to get out of the car because of a child lock or any other reason, please park away from the school and walk.

Remember WOW - Walk to School at least Once Week, or do Park and stride. If you do this you will get a badge at the end of the month and you will be making the local environment a better place.
