pupils throughout the school have settled in so well, you would think they had been pupils here last year!



Reminders

Snacks and Drinks

All pupils will need a named water bottle in school every day which they can refill at the water dispenser should they need more. If parents wish to provide a further drink for lunchtime, that is fine, however we will have some water available for those without a drink or their water bottle in school. KS2 pupils are also encouraged to continue bringing a healthy snack for the morning break time. KS1 and EYFS pupils will continue to be provided with fruit snacks in school during the morning. PLEASE ensure that you send sandwiches, snacks or food items that **DO NOT CONTAIN NUTS OR SEEDS** as we have pupils in school who are highly allergic to these and even touching surfaces they have been on can trigger a serious reaction.

Arrival and Collection from School

The beginning of the new academic year is a good time to remind all parents of the safety rules we currently have in place.

- Please abide by our school opening times and drop your children off between 8:45 and 8:55. A member of staff will be on the front gate to greet the arrivals and keep an eye on the turning circle in the morning and Mrs Ansell will be on duty to look after the pupils on the back playground until the whistle blows at 8:55. Until October half term Reception age pupils may go straight to Owls class with their parents for the 10 minute settling in period.
- Please do not get out of your car in the drop off zone. If you need to pop into the office, or your child is unable to let themselves out of the car, please park further away and walk in with your child.
- Please do not park in the car park after 3pm

Please only park in designated parking spaces, as parking in the entrance way to the village hall and the car park limits the space, blocks the emergency access to the school and is hazardous for the pupils walking past.

There is detailed information about pick up and drop off on the school information pages on the website. We ask all parents to read the information.

Road Safety and Horses

We have been asked by local community members to mention that there are a number of people who ride horses in the area. Horses can easily panic and bolt if startled. The consequences to drivers, their car, the horse and its rider can be horrendous. Drivers can help avoid accidents involving horses on the road by following this advice taken from http://think.direct.gov.uk

- Slow down and be ready to stop if necessary
- Look out for riders' signals to slow down or stop
- Watch out for sudden movements, horses can be easily frightened and unpredictable
- Don't sound your horn or rev your engine
- Pass wide and slow when overtaking; giving the horse plenty of room. Don't accelerate rapidly once you have passed them.

Cohort Meetings

In the school calendar on the website each class has a cohort meeting during the week of 18th September. This meeting is led by the class teacher when they will explain most of the day to day running issues for each class. Next week you will receive a letter setting out what will be taught this coming term, and a copy of this letter will be posted on the school's website. If you are unable to attend the meeting be assured that further information will be made available to you.
